

Official Rules & Regulations

1. Entry for tournament does not include guide and/or boat. All participants must book/ provide a boat
2. All fish and anglers must be in accordance with state and federal regulations, along with Sky High Inaugural Fishing Rodeo Rules and Regulations as seen below
3. Any attempt to circumvent the rules of this event will result in disqualification of the fish and angler
4. Categories for this tournament are Rat Red, Bull Red, Trout, and Flounder
5. In the state of Louisiana, Rat Reds are measured between 16" and 27," Bull Reds are measured over 27.0" in length
6. All categories will be awarded first, second and third place for heaviest fish
7. The fish will be weighed both Friday and Saturday. In the event of a categorical tie, the fish that is entered first wins
8. Weigh ins will be at Bridge Side Marina on Friday, July 19 and Saturday, July 20, 2019 between the hours of 12PM & 3PM. Participants must be in line before 3PM
9. The Weigh Master's decision is final
10. Weigh Master and/or Rodeo Officials reserve the right to open and inspect any fish entered in the rodeo
11. You are entering the Sky High Inaugural Rodeo at your own risk. Bridge Side Marina, Sky High and/or the Sky High Board of Directors, Sky High staff/volunteers, Weigh Masters, sponsors, rodeo officials and rodeo volunteers will not be held liable for any damages or injury suffered at this event
12. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated
13. All fish must be caught with a rod and reel
14. No swapping fish between competitors or teams is allowed
15. All money transactions are final. In the event of weather cancellation, reimbursements are up to Sky High's discretion
